SECTION III: SAFETY MONITOR INFORMATION

Each group must provide at least 2 trained, CONTINGENT MONITORS. For any vehicle, the required number is two per axle. (Most cars/trucks have 2 axles which means you need 4 Contingent Monitors).

For march contingents, the required number is 2 per 25 people. (A contingent of 150 would need 4 Safety Monitors). Contingent monitors are those who will be marching with a specific float or group but are not committed to monitoring at the celebration site. We will be checking their names with the roster of those who have attended a monitor training session. Contingent Monitors are only required to attend the first hour and half hours of one session.

Those interested in being PARADE SAFETY MONITORS for the Celebration, (after serving as Contingent Monitors during the parade) would need to stay for the entire 3-hour training session.

We will notify you as to the exact locations of the training sessions by phone as soon as they are determined. (Please attend an earlier training session if possible, the last sessions are always **very crowded!**)
